



Heliport Conditional Determination

Heliport Proposal, V3 Heli Heliport

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 157 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, **Manager Aeronautical Services**, having received from V3 Heli Limited a Notice of **Heliport** Proposal, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representative groups and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study I am satisfied that the proposed action will **not adversely impact the safe and efficient use of airspace** or be impacted by man made or natural objects, **but may impact the safety of persons or property on the ground and aerodrome traffic circuits.**

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

CONDITIONAL DETERMINATION

in respect of the Notice of Proposal. The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

1. All operations at the heliport must be in accordance with the resource consent conditions issued by Rangitikei District Council for the heliport; and
2. V3 Heli Limited must establish procedures for the proposed heliport that ensure helicopter operations comply with local circuit operations at both Taihape aerodrome (NZVR) and the nearby agricultural airstrip; and
3. All helicopter operations must utilise appropriate radio calls on the local aerodrome frequency (119.1MHz) to ensure that conflicting circuit operations with Taihape aerodrome (NZVR) are minimised; and
4. Proposed approach and departure sectors between 270 degrees – 045 degrees magnetic from the proposed heliport must be utilised at all times, to ensure no overflight of neighbouring dwellings; and
5. All helicopter operations within the vicinity of the heliport must be in accordance with Civil Aviation Rule part 91.127; and
6. V3 Heli Limited is to ensure that the design and layout of the heliport complies with the standard design requirements provided in Advisory Circular 139-8 – Heliports; and
7. In addition to the design requirements provided in Advisory Circular 139-8 – Heliports, V3 Heli Limited is to install fencing with signage around the operational areas of the heliport and install a windsock; and

The provisions of this determination are in addition to and not in derogation of the provisions of any other Act, or any orders or regulations made thereunder

8. V3 Heli Limited is to provide CAA with an annual report of traffic movement data for the heliport, in accordance with CAR Part 139.505 (a).

This conditional determination shall become void on 21st December 2019.
