

## **NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: 4 Awatea Place, Nelson**

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Nelson City Council Limited, notification of intention to install a permanent crane to be available H24 at 4 Awatea Place, Nelson, reviewed an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, could constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE, I HEREBY ISSUE a

### **DETERMINATION OF HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE**

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

1. The crane is not to exceed a maximum height of 12.13m AGL; and
2. The crane is to be lit in accordance with CAA Rule Part 77 Appendix B; and
3. As soon as able, Nelson City Council Limited and Nelson Airport ([mark.thompson@nelsonairport.co.nz](mailto:mark.thompson@nelsonairport.co.nz)) are to agree on and document safe operating procedures for the crane that meet the airport's SMS obligations and Nelson City Council's HSWA obligations. This document must ensure that the risks are mitigated to 'as low as reasonably practicable'. When agreed, a completed copy should be forwarded to CAA (Quote 24/77/21 - [aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz](mailto:aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz)).

This Determination of Hazard shall become final on 5th January 2024 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of Hazard shall not expire but may be revoked, in writing, by the Director.
