

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Smith Cranes Limited – 32 Westpoint Drive, Hobsonville, Auckland.

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Smith Cranes Limited, notification of intention to install and operate a crane at 32 Westpoint Drive, Hobsonville, Auckland, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, could constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

1. Crane operating within the proposed area shall be lit with an appropriate obstacle light in accordance with Civil Aviation Rule Part 77, Appendix B at both the highest point of the Jib and mid-Boom; and
2. Smith Cranes Limited shall inform RNZAF Whenuapai Base Operations at least 48 hours prior to crane being erected on site to allow for the promulgation of a Notice to Airmen (NOTAM) to inform pilots of the crane operation; and
3. Smith Cranes Limited shall advise RNZAF Base Operations and CAA when the crane operating at the site are no longer required.

This Determination of Hazard shall become final on 2nd November 2020 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of Hazard shall not expire but may be revoked, in writing, by the Director.
