



## **NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Crane at 3 Esk Street West, Invercargill.**

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Distinction Hotel Invercargill Limited notification of intention to operate a crane at 3 Esk Street West, Invercargill, reviewed an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

### **DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE**

in respect of the above notification.


The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

1. The crane is not to exceed a maximum height of 65m above ground level (AGL); and
2. Prior to the operation of the crane, Distinction Hotel Invercargill Limited is to contact Rob Somers at Invercargill Airport (M 021 456 170 E [rob.somers@invercargillairport.co.nz](mailto:rob.somers@invercargillairport.co.nz)) to agree on a set of operating conditions for the crane; and
3. Distinction Hotel Invercargill Limited is to notify CAA – Quote 24/77/27 ([aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz](mailto:aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz)) when the crane is lowered and no longer in use.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 17th January 2024 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 17<sup>th</sup> July 2025.
