



NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Crawler Crane at Takitimu Drive, Tauranga (37 42 44.6S 176 07 48.2E)

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Fulton Hogan / HEB Joint Venture Ltd, notification of intention to operate a 280t crawler crane at Takitimu Drive, Tauranga between 12 February 2024 and 28 February 2025, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE, I HEREBY ISSUE A DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- The crane is not to exceed a maximum height of 61m Above Ground Level (AGL); and
- The crane shall be lit with appropriate obstacle lights as stated in the CAA 24077/01A proposal, paragraph 3(C); and
- At least 1 month prior to the expiry date, Fulton Hogan / HEB Joint Venture Ltd is to apply to CAA for an extension - Quote 24/77/43 to aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz; and
- Fulton Hogan / HEB Joint Venture Ltd is to advise the CAA – Quote 24/77/43 (aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz) when the crane at the Takitimu Drive site is lowered and no longer in use.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 3 March 2024 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

The provisions of this determination are in addition to and not in derogation of the provisions of any other Act, or any orders or regulations made thereunder

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 3 September 2025.
