



## **NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: 102 Prices Road, Manukau, Auckland**

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Concrete Solutions Limited, notification of intention to erect cranes at 102 Prices Road, Manukau, Auckland, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, could constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

### **DETERMINATION OF HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE**

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

1. The cranes are not to exceed a maximum height of 45m above ground level (AGL); and
2. The cranes must be lit in accordance with CAR Part 77, Appendix B, with a requirement for medium intensity lights on the highest points of all the cranes within the site; and
3. Prior to operating on the cranes, Concrete Solutions must notify Aeropath (Quote 24/77/48 – Part77@aeropath.aero) and request the instrument flight procedures (IFP) are adjusted according to the Aeropath assessment; and
4. Concrete Solutions Limited is to advise the CAA – Quote 24/77/48 (aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz) when the cranes operating at the site are no longer required; and
5. When the cranes operating at the Prices Road site are no longer required, Concrete Solutions Limited is to advise Aeropath – (Quote 24/77/48 (Part77@aeropath.aero) to request the IFPs are restored to normal.

This Determination of Hazard shall become final on 15<sup>th</sup> May 2024 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

*The provisions of this determination are in addition to and not in derogation of the provisions of any other Act, or any orders or regulations made thereunder.*

This Determination of Hazard shall not expire but may be revoked, in writing, by the Director.
