Exemption from the Requirement in Civil Aviation Rule CAR 61.307(a)

PURSUANT TO Section 37 of the Civil Aviation Act 1990,

- I, Graeme Harris, Director of Civil Aviation, being satisfied that—
 - (a) The requirement in CAR 61.307(a) relating to the recent experience required before exercising the privileges of an E category instructor rating is clearly inappropriate in activities where the instructor is not required to manipulate the controls of an aircraft; and
 - (b) the risk to safety will not be significantly increased by the granting of this exemption,

HEREBY EXEMPT—

Persons holding an E Category Instructor Rating

who may be required to give agricultural flight instruction

FROM—

the requirement in Civil Aviation Rule CAR 61.307(a) that the holder of a Category E flight instructor rating must not give agricultural flight instruction unless, within the immediately preceding 90 days, the flight instructor has carried out a minimum of 10 hours agricultural aircraft operations flight time in the same type of agricultural flying (topdressing or spraying) in the same category of aircraft,

ONLY WITH RESPECT TO

The activities detailed in CAR 61.305(a)(2),(4), and (5); and

PROVIDED THAT—

The person's commercial pilot licence and agricultural rating are current.

This exemption shall remain in effect unless withdrawn in writing by the Director.
