



Aerodrome Conditional Determination

Aerodrome Proposal, Auckland Harbour Aerodrome

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 157 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Michael John Haines, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Auckland Seaplanes Limited a Notice of Aerodrome/Heliport Proposal, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representative groups and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study I am satisfied that the proposed action will not adversely affect the safety of persons or property on the ground or impact on the safe and efficient use of airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

CONDITIONAL DETERMINATION

in respect of the Notice of Proposal. The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- The operator of the Auckland Harbour Aerodrome must conform to the safety standards published in CAA Advisory Circular AC139-7 for water aerodromes; and
- The aerodrome must be published in Volume 4 of the AIP New Zealand.

This conditional determination shall become void on 8th October 2014.
