**NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION- 84 Buckley Avenue, Hobsonville Point, Auckland.**

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from ASPEC Construction Limited, notification of intention to erect a crane at 84 Buckley Avenue, Hobsonville Point, Auckland, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE, I HEREBY ISSUE a

**DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE**

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

1. The crane is to be lit at the highest point at all times in accordance with CAA Rule Part 77 Appendix B; and
2. The crane is not to exceed 46.25m AMSL; and
3. When the crane operating at the Buckley Avenue site is lowered and no longer in use, ASPEC Construction Limited is to notify CAA (Quote 22/77/74 [aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz](mailto:aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz)); and
4. When the crane operating at the Buckley Avenue site is lowered and no longer in use, ASPEC Construction Limited is to notify RNZAF Base Operations, Auckland.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 26<sup>th</sup> August 2022 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 26<sup>th</sup> February 2024 or when the crane is lowered and no longer in use, whichever is earlier.
