



NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Softball Floodlighting and Ball Tracker, Colquhoun Park, Palmerston North

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Palmerston North City Council, notification of intention to operate vertically oriented Floodlights and a Ball tracker at Colquhoun Park, Fairs Rd, Palmerston North, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, could constitute no hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

1. Palmerston North City Council is to generate a NOTAM proposal for any intended use of the lighting in accordance with the granted Resource Consent requirements. This NOTAM should reference Palmerston North Airport (NZPM).

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 1st of April 2020 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 1st day of October 2021.
