

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Ravensdown, 292 Main South Road, Hornby, Christchurch.

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Smith Cranes Limited, notification of intention to operate a crane at Ravensdown, 292 Main South Road, Hornby, Christchurch, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- The crane shall be lit with an appropriate obstacle light in accordance with Civil Aviation Rule Part 77, Appendix B at the highest point of the Jib; and
- Smith Cranes Limited shall advise CAA when the crane operating at the Main South Road site is no longer required.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 9th November 2020 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 9th May 2022.
