

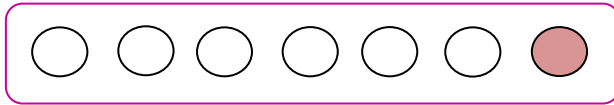
ATPL Examination Credits (rule 61.17)

Various Examples

Transition Date
11 May 06

Requirements

1. All Exam Passes complete prior 11 May 06

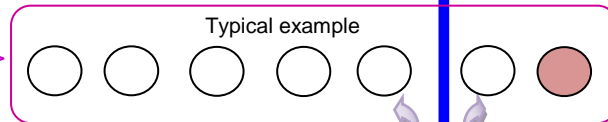


ATPL Written Exam Credit valid for 10 years from the date on which the last subject was passed

Must have ATPL issued within 10 years after the date on which the last ATPL subject was passed.

2. Partial completion of exams during transition

Once last Exam Pass completed this becomes a Written Exam Credit
Rule ref: 61.17(c)



Must be ATPL subject pass credits gained before 11 May 2006

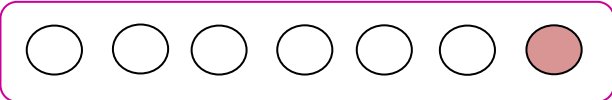
Must be ATPL exam pass credits gained after 11 May 2006 & before **11 May 2011**

Must have ATPL issued within 10 years after the date on which the last ATPL subject was passed.

3. Exams started after 11 May 06

All **ATPL** Exam Passes need to be completed within 3 years
Rule ref: 61.17(c)(2)

Have 10 years* to have **ATPL** issued from date of last Exam Pass ●
Rule ref: 61.17(d)(1)



Legend:

- Written Exam Pass
- Written Exam Pass – last subject
- Written Exam Credit - is achieved once all pre-requisite Exams Passes completed

Notes:

1. This is presented as a pictorial representation of the rule requirements which should be referred to for any further clarification.
2. Written Exam Credit - valid for 10 years as pre-requisite for both flight test and licence issue.
3. * Air Law Exam Pass - valid for 5 years only.
