### **CAA Horizon**

- Introduction of EMPIC
  - New CAA business system
  - Aircraft Registration module is in design & acceptance phase
  - Aircraft & Product Certification is in requirements phase
  - Through to mid 2024.
- ICAO Safety Audit preparation
  - Review of processes, procedures, work tools, etc.
- Preparation and implementation of the new Civil Aviation Act 2023
  - Review of Rules, Delegations, etc.
- On-going AC reviews
  - e.g. AC21-5 Approval of modifications covering aircraft ferry fuel systems and overweight operation
